



Navigating COPD Care

It can be difficult to navigate the health care system when managing COPD. According to the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid, 1 in 5 patients admitted to the hospital with a COPD exacerbation is readmitted within 30 days of discharge (3). The following strategies are designed to help you navigate the system and avoid a hospital readmission:

1 Work with care management, a discharge coordinator, and family liaison to develop a management plan

2 Ask questions and read RHA's "Making the Most of Your Doctor's Appointment"

3 Be familiar with your long term health insurance

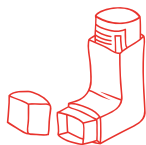
4 Research services to ensure they meet your needs:

- Be familiar with home health organizations
- Medical equipment and oxygen
